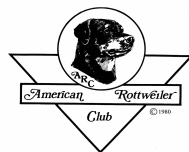

Directions to Test/Trial Location

From I-25, take the Highway 34 Greeley exit and go east to 35th Ave. Turn left (north) and go to 10th St. Turn right (east), and go to 14th Ave. Turn left (north) and follow 14th Ave. into Island Grove Regional Park.

From Highway 85, follow Highway 85 north in to Greeley. Highway 85 turns in to 8th Ave. Go to 5th St., and turn left (west). Go to 14th Ave., turn right (north) and follow 14th Ave. into Island Grove Regional Park.

Notice to Exhibitors

Test/Trial location will be available from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm each day, or one hour after conclusion of event. No unentered dogs (except set-out dogs) will be allowed at the test/trial site. Bring your own canopies. Cool off tubs will be provided for dogs if needed. No RVs, Trailers, or Tents may camp at the trial site without site owners permission. Please bring your own chairs. A food concession will be available in or near the arena for this event. Schedule will be provided. Bitches in season will be allowed but will be moved to the end of the class in test. Please notify the secretary if your bitch is in season.

ALL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RULES REGARDING CONDUCT WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after closing of entries. **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY. NO CONDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

A separate entry blank must be completed for each dog entered. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Forms are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**. You can, however, use the same entry form for both days and for more than one class and/or stock as long as all entries are for the same dog. Owners or their Agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the test/trial arena.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent (unless replaced by an alternate), disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Test/Trial committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the Test/Trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Entries close at Secretary's house 7:00 pm, Wednesday, March 24, 2010 after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. All fees are payable in U.S. funds.
